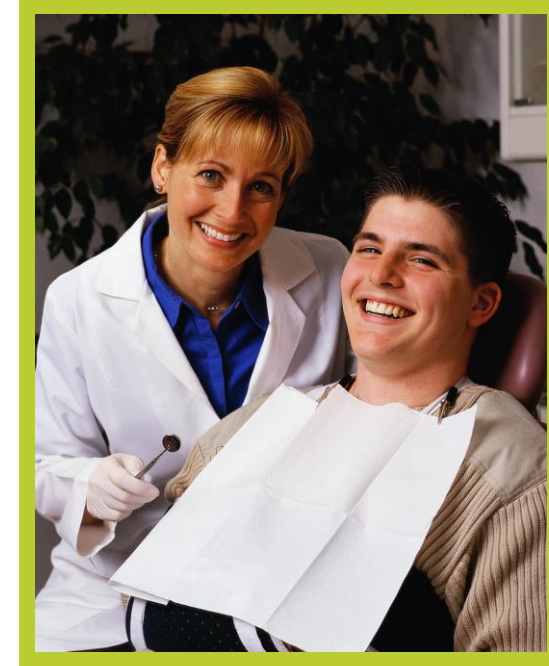
Keep a Healthy Smile

Services: Bridge clinics offer services including screenings and exams, x-rays, cleanings, fillings and extractions. At the Wausau clinic we offer partials, bridges, and dentures.

Eligibility: MA, BadgerCare, Insured, Low-Income (Uninsured). Clinics provide care to all individuals, with an emphasis on those with Medicaid. A dental financial assistance program is available to help patients that have limited income and have out-of-pocket dental expenses at all Bridge Clinics.

Eligibility: Serves all patients, regardless of ability to pay or insurance status (uninsured/underinsured, private pay and commercial insurance).

A dental financial assistance program is available to help patients that have limited income and have out-of-pocket dental expenses at both Medford and Rhineland Dental Clinics.
